At the April Executive Meeting, the subject of associate members was raised. >> The executive has researched this option, in light of the fact that our membership has reached capacity; there is an extensive waiting list. Since this is a

quilt show year, we anticipate more interest because of it.

>> We feel associate membership might suit some members who live a distance away, or who would like a lower level of involvement in the guild, freeing up a space for members who would like to become more active in executive, etc.

> Associate membership would be offered only to current Full members, and only when our membership is at its maximum capacity of 100.

>> The guidelines for associate membership would be as follows.

>> An associate member would:

- >> - not be able to hold an office
- >> - not have voting or library privileges
- >> - pay reduced membership fee (\$15.)
- >> - receive the newsletters and a membership list
- >> - be able to attend a workshop at a lower priority than regular members
- >> - be able to attend one guild meeting a year, if more, would pay the guest fee (\$5.)
- >> - be able to display one quilt in the Quilt Show
