Goose Tracks

- A  2 (5 7/8 inch squares) cut once on diagonal. 4 triangles **colour#1**
- B  4 (3inch squares) **background**
- C  4 (2 ½ X 5 ½ inch) rectangles) **background**
- D  1 (2 ½ x2 ½ inch square) **colour#2**
- E  2 (3 ¾ inch square) **colour #3** cut twice on the diagonal. 8 triangles.
- F  2 (3 ¾ inch square) **background** cut twice on the diagonal. 8 triangles

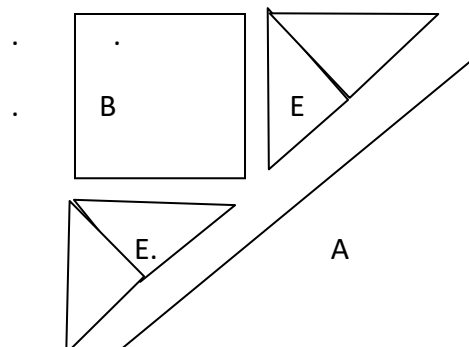
Construction

1. Sew an F background to an E colour #3.
more with F on right E on left.



Make 4Make 4

2. Join 1 unit to opposite sides of a 3inch background square.



3. Sew an A **colour # 1** triangle to each of the 4 units completed in step #2. Goose Track made.
4. Sew a **background** C rectangle between 2 Goose Tracks. Make 2. See photo at top.
5. Sew a D colour # 2 square between 2 C **background** rectangles.
6. Sew a Goose Track to the top and bottom of the unit just made. See photo.
7. You are done.
