

Materials and Cutting


Background	12 squares 2 ½ x2 ½ inches 4 squares 2 7/8 x 2 7/8 inches
Print # 1	1 square 4 ½ x4 ½ inches 4 squares 2 7/8 x 2 7/8 inches 4 squares 2 ½ x 2 ½ inches
Print # 2	4 squares 4 ½ x 4 ½ inches

Piecing the Block


 Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a 2 7/8 inch background square. Place marked square RST with a print #1 2 7/8 inch square. Sew a ¼ inch seam on each side of marked line; cut apart on line. Open and press to dark to make 2 pieced HST. Repeat with other 3 squares to make 8 HST.



 Sew together 1 each 2 ½ inch squares of background and print #1 and 2 HST to make corner unit. Make 4.



 Draw a line on the wrong side of (8) 2 ½ inch background squares. Place square RST on corner of print # 3 - 4 ½ inch square. Sew on line, trim excess and press. Add a second square to the adjacent corner. Make 4.



4. Referring to the diagram of the block sew your units into horizontal rows and then sew the rows to complete the block.

NOTE

- HST half square triangles
- RST right sides together.
