
12 ½ inches (12 inches finished)
Star Puzzle – Ladies Art Company 1897
Also known as
Windmill Quilt 1928
Barbara Frietchie Star-NancyPage-1933
Pieced Star-1933
The Colorado Quilt-Kansas City Star- 1941

Cutting

Background	8 - 3½ inch squares 4 – 3 7/8 Inch squares cut once on the diagonal
Print # 1	4 - 3 7/8 inch squares cut once on the diagonal
Print # 2	4 – 6 ½ inch by 3 ½ inch rectangles

Construction

- 1. Make 8 HST using the background and print #1 triangles.
- 2. Draw a diagonal line on the 3 ½ inch background squares. Place RST on the end of the 6 ½ by 3 ½ inch rectangle and sew on line. Fold to check corner is correct then flip back and cut ¼ inch from stitching line. Press Repeat on the opposite end. Note the orientation you are not making flying geese units. Make 4 propeller units.
- 3. Assemble units in quadrants.



Note there is **no** line in center of unit.
