## Materials

Neutral tone on tone and 2 contrasting prints.

## Cutting

| Background | Cut (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ inch strip by width of the fabric. <br> Cut into (4) $4 \frac{1}{2} \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangles and (4) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ inch <br> squares. <br> Cut (1) $27 / 8$ inch strip by width of the fabric. <br> Cut into (10) $27 / 8$ inch squares. <br> Cut once on the diagonal to yield 20 triangles. |
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| Print \#1 | Cut (1) $47 / 8 \times 10$ inch strip <br> Cut into (2) $47 / 8$ inch squares. <br> Cut once on the diagonal to yield 4 triangles. |
| Print \# 2 | Cut (1) $27 / 8$ inch strip by the width of the fabric. <br> Cut into (10) $27 / 8$ inch squares. <br> Cut once on the diagonal to yield 20 triangles. |

## Construction

- Sew a print \# 2 triangle to 2 adjacent sides of a $21 / 2$ inch $B G$ square.
- Make 4.
- Sew a print \# 1 triangle to the unit you just made. Make 4.

- Join 4 units just made to form a pinwheel in the center.
- Make 12 half square triangles with the remaining BG and print \# 2 triangles.

- Join 2 HST units just made to a $41 / 2 \times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ inch BG rectangle.
- Make 4.

- Sew 1 of these units to the top and the bottom of the pinwheel unit. WATCH ORIENTATION.
- Sew a HST unit to each end of the remaining 2 rectangle units. WATCH ORIENTATION.
- Sew to the other two sides of the pinwheel.
