| Fabric | Number | Size |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Light | 1 | $31122^{\prime \prime} \times 3112{ }^{\prime \prime}$ (center square) |
| Dark | 4 | $31 / 2 \prime$ X 5 " rectangles |
| Light | 16 | 2 " squares |
| Light | 2 | $53 / 8{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 53 / 8$ " squares |
| Dark ** | 2 | $53 / 8$ " X5 3/8" squares |

** These are the HST units. You may choose to cut them larger and trim to the correct size after stitching.

## Making The Units

## HST Make 4

Draw a diagonal line on the back of the light and dark 5 3/8 "squares.
RST one light and one dark square stitch $1 / 4$ "on each side of the drawn line.
Cut apart on the drawn line and press to the dark. Measures 5 inches
Repeat with the other pair of squares.
Yield 4 HST

## Making The Side Units

_Drawn Line

Draw a diagonal line on the back of all 16 light squares
Use the sew and flip method to add a square to each corner of the $31 / 2$ " X 5 " dark rectangle. Trim excess corners.


Repeat with the other 3 dark rectangles and 2 inch light squares.
4 side units made.
Assembling Your Block
Arrange your units as in the diagram at the top.
Sew the units together into rows.
Sew the rows together to complete your block.
(As you would a 9 patch block.)
