Flower Basket

9 1/2 x 9 1/2 -9 inches finished

Materials

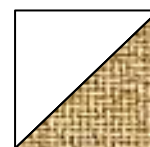
- A background fabric
- A basket fabric

Cutting

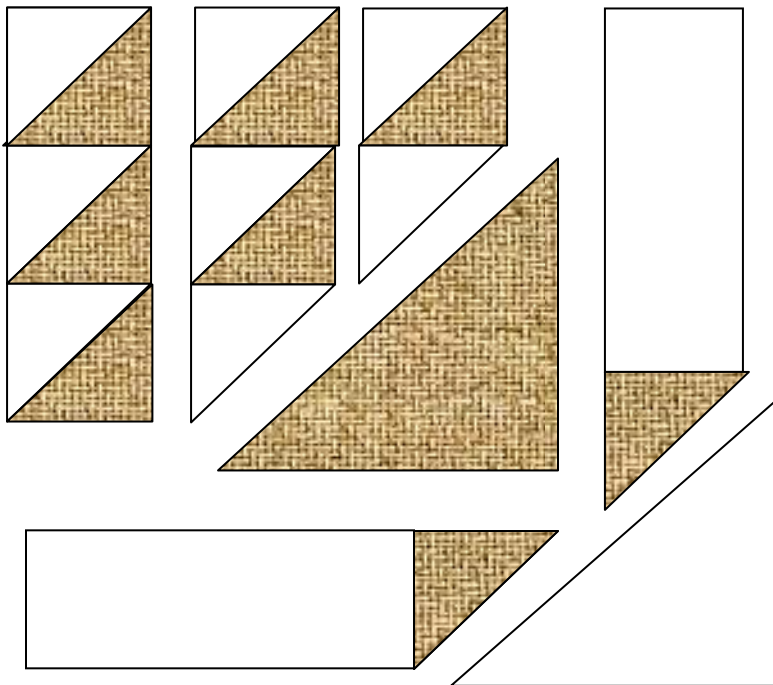
Light Background	A	8 	(1) strip 2 3/4 " X 12 "	Cut (4) 2 3/4 " squares	Cut each in half on the diagonal
Light Background	B	1 	(1) 5 3/8 " square	Cut in half on the diagonal	You will only need one of these triangles.
Light Background	C	2 	(1) strip 2 3/4 " x 10 "	Cut (2) 5" rectangles	
Dark Basket Fabric	D	8 	(1) strip 2 3/4 " X 12"	Cut (4) 2 3/4 " squares	Cut each in half on the diagonal
Dark Basket Fabric	E	1 	(1) 5 3/8" square	Cut in half on the diagonal	You will need only one of these triangles.

Construction

1. Using (6) A and D triangles sew together on the diagonal to make 6 HST units.



2. Sew 3 HST units together.
3. Sew 2 HST units together and add a background triangle
4. Sew a background triangle to the last HST



5. Sew the 3 units together.
6. Sew a large triangle E to the bottom of the unit just completed.
7. Sew a dark fabric D triangle to the end of a light C rectangle.
8. Sew a dark fabric D triangle to the end of the other light C rectangle. Watch the orientation.
9. Sew a large triangle B to the bottom of the unit.
