Sugar Bowl

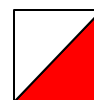
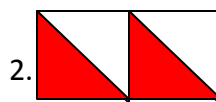
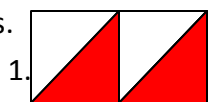
12 ½ inches x 12 ½ Inches (12 inches finished)

Cutting

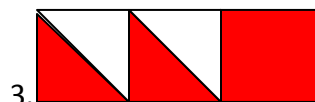
Light A	2  = 4 	Cut (2) 3 ¼ inch squares Cut once on the diagonal
Light B	1  = 2 	Cut (1) 5 3/8 inch square. Cut once on the diagonal.
Light C	2 	Cut (2) 2 ¾ X 5 inch rectangles.
Dark D	1 	Cut (1) 2 ¾ inch square.
Dark E	3  = 6 	Cut (3) 3 ¼ inch squares. Cut each once on the diagonal.
Dark F	1  = 1 	Cut (1) 5 3/8 inch square. Cut once on the diagonal. You only need 1 triangle.

Constructing the Units

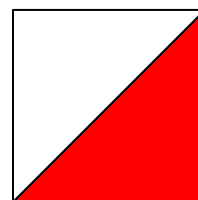
- Using 4 light **A** triangles and 4 dark **E** triangles make 4 HSTs. (Half Square Triangles)
- Sew these units into 2 pairs.
- Note they are opposite.



- Add the **D** 2 ¾ inch square to the end of # 2 pair.

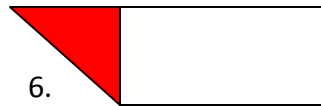
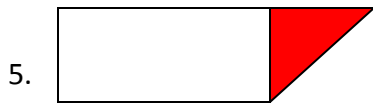


- Sew 1 **B** light triangle to 1 **F** dark triangle on the diagonal.

- Sew the remaining dark **E** triangles to the end of the light **C** rectangles.
- Note direction. They are opposite.



Assembling the Block.

1. Sew unit 1 to the top of unit 4. Press
2. Sew unit 3 to the left side of the unit 1-4.
3. Sew unit 5 to the left side of unit just completed.
4. Sew unit 6 to the other side.
5. Sew remaining light **B** triangle to the bottom.
