

Block of the Month January 2020 Spring Basket 9 ½ X 9 ½ - 9 inches finished

Cutting

Light A	3	= 6	Cut (3) 3 ¼ inch squares. Cut in half once on the diagonal to give 6 triangles. You need 5.
Light B	1		Cut (1) 2 ¾ inch square
Light C	2		Cut (2) 2 ¾ X 5 inch rectangles
Light D	1	= 2	Cut (1) 5 3/8 inch square. Cut once on the diagonal to give 2 triangles. You will need 1.
Medium E	4	= 8	Cut (4) 3 ¼ inch squares. Cut in half once on the diagonal to give 8 triangles. You need 7
Dark F	1	= 2	Cut (1) 3 ¼ inch square. Cut in half once on the diagonal to give 2 triangles. You need 2.
Dark G	1	= 2	Cut (1) 5 3/8 inch square. Cut once on the diagonal to give 2 triangles. You will need 1.

Note: Save any extra triangles to use in some of the other baskets as the sizes are often the same.

Construction of Units


- Take 5 light A triangles and 5 medium E triangles. Place RST and stitch on the diagonal. Pres to dark. Your HST should measure 2 ¾ inches.
- Take 2 medium E triangles and 2 dark F triangles. Place RST and stitch on the diagonal.
- Press to the dark. You HST Should measure 2 ¾ inches.
- Take 1 light D triangle and 1 dark G triangle. Place RST and stitch on the diagonal. Press to the dark.
- Your HST should measure 5 inches.

Note RST-right sides together HST-half square triangle

Assembling Your Block


1. Join 2 A E HST together.









3. Join units from step 1 and 2 together.



4. Join 1 A E HST to 1 E F HST.




5. Add 1 light C unit to the right side of the unit completed in step 4.



6. Join 1 A E HST to 1 E F HST. Note orientation.



- 7. Add 1 light C unit to the left side of the unit completed in step 6.
- 8. Join Step 3 unit to step 5 unit. See completed block at top.
- 9. Join Step 7 unit to the 5 inch dark light HST.
- 10. Join step 8 and 9 units together.
