














Block of the Month

February 2020

Basket 9 ½ inches X 9 ½ inches 9 inches finished

Cutting you will need background and a light medium and dark for this block

Background A	Cut (1) 2 ¾ inch  Cut (2) 2 ¾ X 5 inch  Cut (2) 3 ¼ inch  Cut once on the diagonal = (4)  Cut (1) 5 3/8 inch  Cut once on the diagonal. You will only need 1 of the triangles.
Light B	Cut (1) 3 1/4 inch square. Cut in half on the diagonal to give  (2)  <i>This is the floral in my block.</i>
Medium C	Cut (1) 2 ¾ inch squares.  Cut (2) 3 ¼ inch  Cut in half on the diagonal to Give (4) 
Dark D	Cut (1) 3 1/4 inch  Cut once on the diagonal to give (2)  Cut (1) 5 3/8 inch  Cut once on the diagonal. You will need only 1 of the triangles.

Making the Units.

- Take 4 background triangles and 4 medium C triangles and sew on the diagonal to make 4 HST Units. Press to the medium.



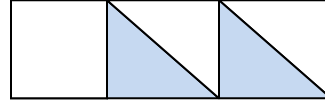
- Take 2 light B triangles and 2 dark D triangles and sew on the diagonal to make 2 HST units. Press to the dark.



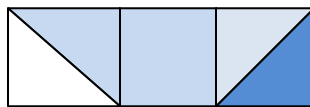
- Take 1 light A large triangle and 1 dark D large triangle and sew on the diagonal to make 1 HST. Press to the dark.

Making the Block

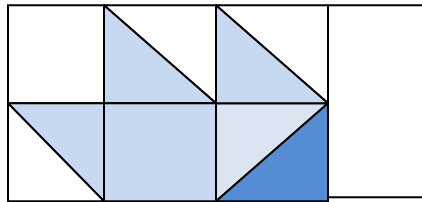
1. Join (2) AC HST units.



2. Add the A $2\frac{3}{4}$ inch square to the unit.
3. Join an AC HST unit to the $2\frac{3}{4}$ inch C medium square and a BD dark light HST.

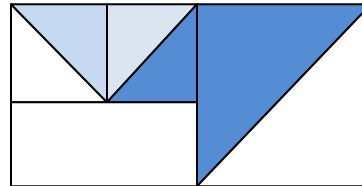


4. Join the two units just made on the long side.



5. Join an A $2\frac{3}{4}$ X 5 inch rectangle to the ride side of the unit just made.

6. Join an AC HST to and BD HST.



7. Join an A $2\frac{3}{4}$ inch rectangle o the bottom of the unit just made.
8. Join the large AD HST to the right side of this unit just made,
9. Join the units from #4 and #6 on the long sides to complete the block.
