9 ½ inches X 9 ½ inches – 9 inches finished.

Materials

Background

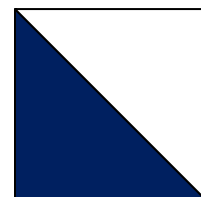
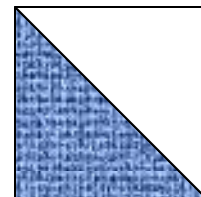
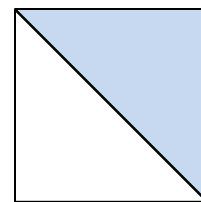
3 coordinating fabrics

Cutting

Background	(1) 2 ¾ inch square (2) 2 ¾ inch X 5 inch rectangles (4) 3 ¼ inch squares (1) 5 ¼ inch square	Cut once on the diagonal to give 8 triangles. Cut once on the diagonal. You will need only 1 of these triangles.
Fabric # 1	(1) 3 ¼ inch square	Cut once on the diagonal
Fabric # 2	(2) 3 ¼ inch squares	Cut once on the diagonal. You will need only 3 of these triangles.
Fabric # 3	(1) 3 ¼ inch square. (1) 5 ¼ inch square	Cut once on the diagonal. Cut once on the diagonal. You will need only 1 of these triangles.

Making the Units

1. Sew a background triangle to a fabric # 1 triangle on the diagonal.
2. Press to the dark.
3. Should measure 2 ¾ inches
4. Make 4.
5. Sew a background triangle to a fabric #2 triangle on the diagonal.
6. Press to the dark.
7. Should measure 2 ¾ inches.
8. Make 3
9. Sew a background triangle to a fabric # 3 triangle on the diagonal.
10. Press to the dark.
11. Should measure 2 ¾ inches.
12. Make 2

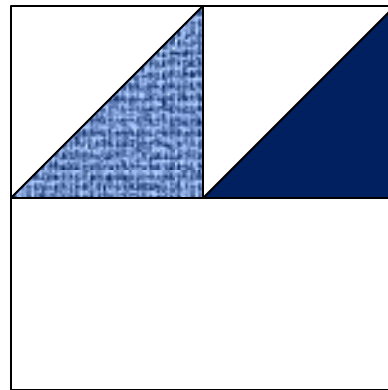
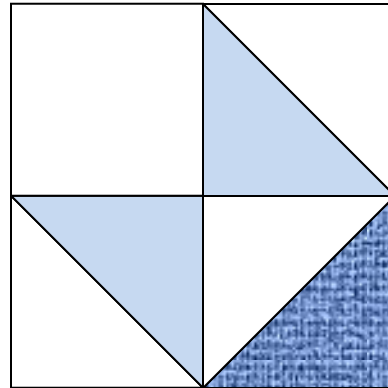


13. Sew a background triangle made from the 5 ¼ inch square to the fabric # 3 triangle made from the 5 ¼ inch square.
14. Press to the dark
15. Make 1
16. Should measure 5 inches.

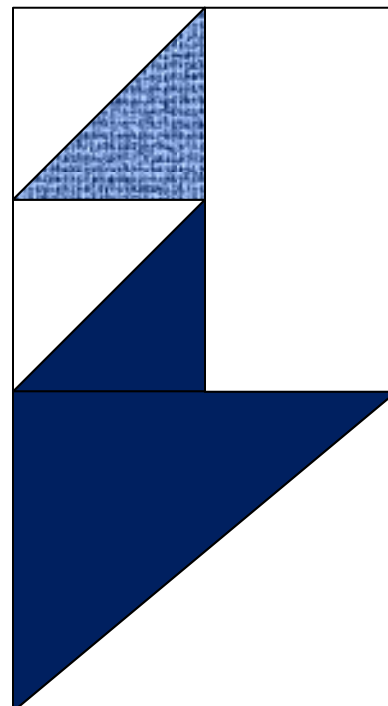
Making the Block

1. Sew a 2 ¾ inch BG square to a fabric # 1 HST
2. Sew a fabric # 1 HST to a fabric # 2 HST.
3. Sew units together as in diagram.

4. Sew a BG/fabric # 2 HST to a BG/fabric # 3 HST
5. Sew a BG 2 ¾ X 5 inch rectangle to the bottom of the unit.
6. Sew these 2 units together. (Left side of the block.)



7. Sew a BG/ fabric # 2 HST to BG # 3 HST.
8. Sew a BG 2 ¾ X 5 inch rectangle on the right side.
9. Sew the large BG/fabric # 3 HST to the unit.
10. Sew units together. This is the right side of the block.
11. Join the 2 sections.
