Materials

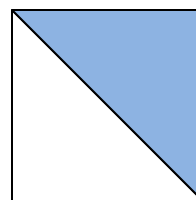
Background- BG Colour A Colour B Colour C

Cutting

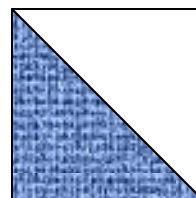
Background	Cut 2 (3 ¼) inch squares Cut 2 (2 ¾) inch squares. Cut 2 (2 ¾ X 5) inch rectangles Cut 1 (5 3/8) inch square	Cut 2 once on the diagonal to give 4 triangles Cut once on the diagonal. You only need 1 of the triangles.
Fabric A	Cut 2 (3 ¼) inch squares.	Cut once on the diagonal to give 4 triangles. You will only need 3.
Fabric B	Cut 1 (2 ¾) inch square. Cut 1 (3 ¼) inch square.	Cut in half once on the diagonal. You will need only 1 triangle.
Fabric C	Cut 2 (2 ¾ X 5 ¼) inch rectangles. Cut 1 (2 ¾) inch square.	Cut once on the diagonal to give 2 triangles.

Making the Units

1. Make 3 HST units with the BG and Colour A triangles.



2. Make 1 HST unit with a BG and Fabric B triangle.



3. Take the 2 (2 ¾) inch background squares and the 2 (2 ¾ X 5) inch fabric C rectangles and using the sew and flip method stitch to one end. Note these will be mirror image.



Trim ¼ inch from your sewing line and press open.

4. Sew a fabric C triangle to the end of a BG 2 ¾ X 5 inch rectangle.



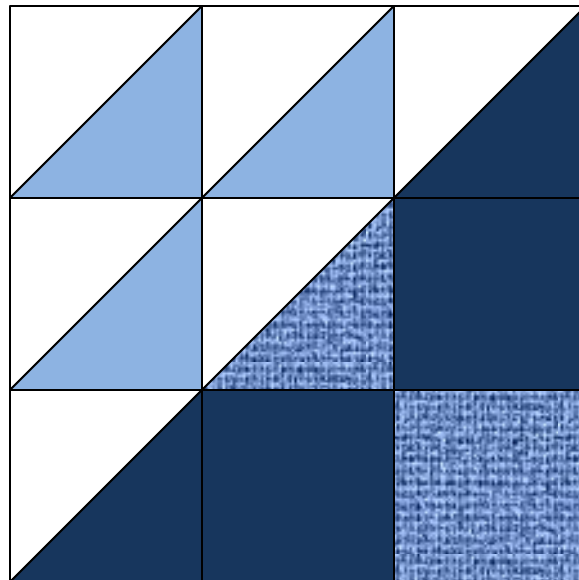
Make a second one. Note the direction.



5. Join 2 of the units made in #1

6. Join a unit # 1 and a unit # 2

7. Sew these 2 units together.



8. Sew a unit made in # 3 to the right side of the above.

9. Sew the B ($2\frac{3}{4}$) inch square to the end of the other #3 unit.
10. Sew to the left side of the main unit.
11. Sew the units made in #4 to the appropriate side of the main unit.
12. Add the large BG triangle to the bottom.
