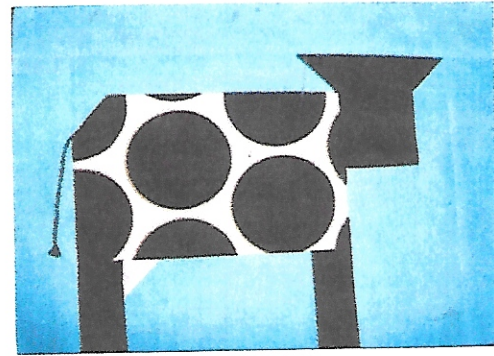


COW BLOCK

(for mystery row-by-row quilt)



From cow fabric cut: one 4 1/2" x 7" mark A
 From head fabric cut: One 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" Mark B
 From ear fabric: cut one 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Mark EAR
 From legs fabric cut: two 1 1/2" x 3" mark C
 From udder fabric cut: one 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" Mark UDDER

From background fabric cut:

one 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" mark EAR	one 3" x 5" Mark H
one 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" Mark D	one 1 3/4" x 8" Mark J
one 2 1/2" x 5" mark E	one 1 3/4" x 8" Mark K
one 1 1/2" x 6" Mark F	one 3" x 12 1/2" Mark L
one 1 1/2" x 7" mark G	

Make body: Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on background D.

With RST place it on top left of body A. Sew on the line.

Trim to 1/4". Open out and press.

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on UDDER.

With RST place at top left of background H. Sew on the line. Trim to 1/2". Open out and press. Sew legs C to either side of this unit.

Sew legs to lower side of cow body.

Make ears: With RST place EAR on top of background EAR. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Sew 1/4" on either side of line. Cut apart on line. Open out and press to make two ear units. **Square to 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"**.

Sew one ear to right side of background F, making sure the ear colour is at the top right. Sew the other ear unit to the top of background G, making sure the ear colour is at the top left.

Sew F (ear unit) to top of cow body A.

Sew head B to background E and sew this to right side of cow.

Sew the other ear unit to the right side of cow head.

Sew background K to right side of cow block, and background J to left side of cow block. Sew background L (3" x 12 1/2") to top of block. Square block to 9 1/2" x 12 1/2".

Add a tail with embroidery floss. Eyes are optional.

You will need three cow blocks and one flower block for this row.
