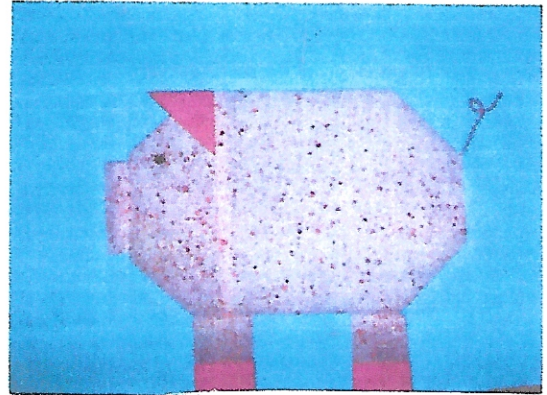


## PIG BLOCK

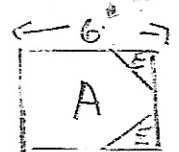
(for mystery row-row-row quilt)

Body: one 5 1/2" x 6" Mark A  
 Head: one 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" Mark B  
 Legs: two 1 3/4" x 1 1/2" Mark C  
 Feet: two 1" x 1 3/4" Mark D  
 Snout: one 1" x 2 1/2" Mark SNOUT  
 Ear: one 2" x 2" Mark EAR



From background fabric cut:

two 2" x 2" Mark E	one 2" x 4 1/2" Mark K
two 2" x 2" Mark F	one 2" x 2 1/2" Mark L
two 1" x 2" Mark G	one 2" x 4" Mark M
one 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" mark H	one 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" Mark N
one 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" Mark J	



Body: Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on backgrounds E.  
 Place on top right and lower right of body A. Sew on the line.  
 Trim seam to 1/4". Open out and press.

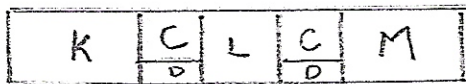
Head: Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on backgrounds F.  
 Place one on top left of head and one on lower left of head. Sew  
 on line. Trim seam to 1/4". Open out and press.

Draw a diagonal line on EAR. Place at top right of head, making  
 making sure ear colour is at the top right. Sew on line. Trim seam to 1/4". Open out  
 and press. Sew the head unit to left side of body A.

Snout: Sew one background G to top of snout and one background G to lower end of snout.  
 Sew snout unit to left side of pig block.

Sew background H to left side of pig block and background J to right side of pig block.

Legs: Sew feet D to lower end of each leg C.  
 Sew leg section together as shown in the diagram.  
 Sew legs to bottom of pig block.



Sew N background (3 1/2" x 12 1/2" to top of block.  
 Square to 9 1/2" x 12 1/2".

You will need three pig blocks and one flower block for  
 this row.
