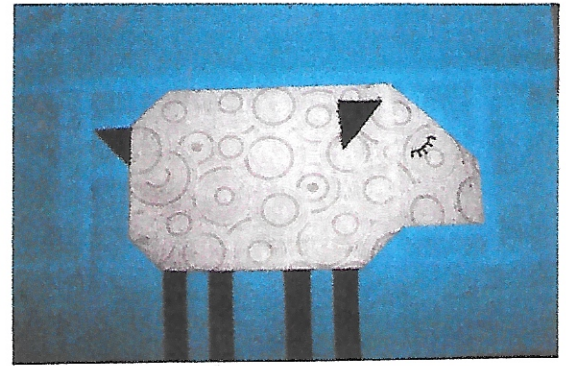


SHEEP BLOCK

(for mystery row-by-row quilt)



From sheep fabric cut: one rectangle 5" x 7" (body) Mark A
 one rectangle 2 1/2" x 4" (head) Mark B

From tail fabric cut: one square 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" Mark C

From leg fabric cut: four 1" x 2 1/2" Mark D

From background fabric cut:

three 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" Mark E

one 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Mark G

one 1 1/2" x 3" Mark J

one 2 1/4" x 5" Mark L

cut two 1" x 2 1/2" Mark N

one 2 1/2" x 5 1/4" Mark P

one 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Mark F

two 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" Mark H

one 1 1/2" x 5" Mark K

one 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" Mark M

one 1 3/4" x 2 1/2" Mark O

one 3 1/2" x 12 1/2" Mark Q

Make the body: Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on each E square.

With RST place one on top left, lower left and lower right corners of body.

Sew on line. Trim seam to 1/4". Open out and press.

Make the head: Draw a diagonal line on background square F. Place RST on top of head B. Sew on the line. Trim seam to 1/4". Open out and press.

Sew background G to lower edge of head. Sew this unit to right side of body A.

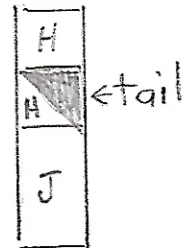
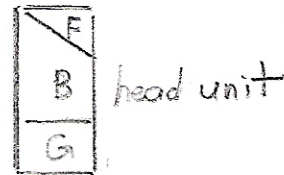
Make the tail section: With RST place tail C on top of a background H square.

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner. Stitch on line. Trim seam to 1/4".

Open out and press. Sew the other background H to top of this unit, making sure tail C is positioned at the top right. Sew background J to lower end of this unit. Sew this unit to left side of body section. Press.

Sew background K to left side of sheep block, and background L to right side.

Make the legs: Sew legs and background pieces together as shown, and sew to lower edge of body.



Add background Q (3 1/2" x 12 1/2") to top of block.

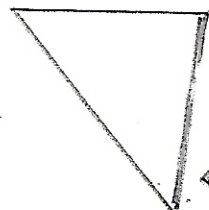
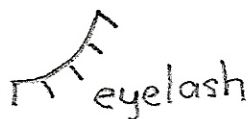
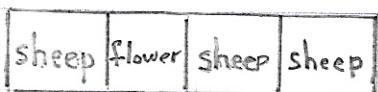
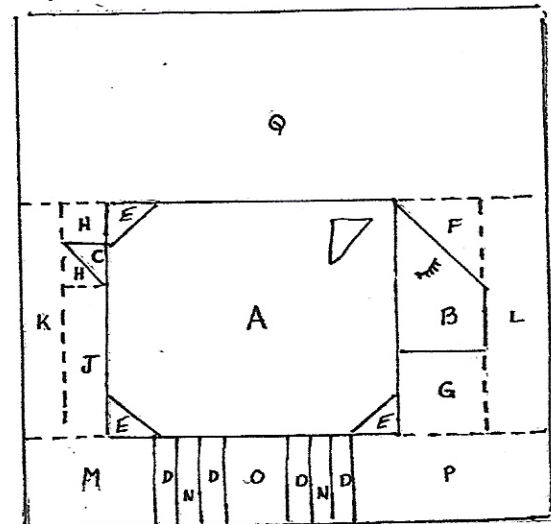
Square block to 9 1/2" x 12 1/2". Embroidery eyelashes to face.

To make the ear: Use the template to cut ear shape.

You can use fusible web and machine applique for the ear, or use hand applique (add seam allowance for this method)

You can use a machine stitch close to the edge of the ear as in raw edge applique, or blanket stitch around the edge.

You will need three sheep blocks and one flower block for this row.
