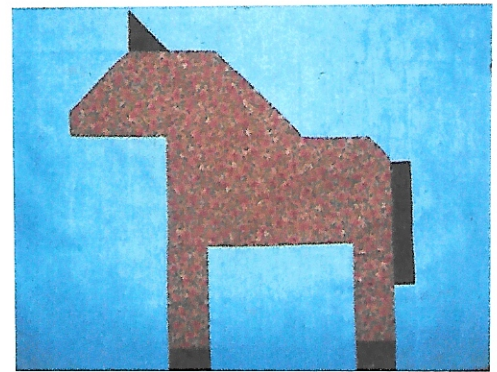


HORSE BLOCK

(for mystery row-by-row quilt)

From body fabric cut: one 3" x 6" (body) Mark A
 one 2 1/2" x 6" (head) Mark B
 two 1 1/2" x 3" (legs) Mark C
 from tail fabric cut: one 1" x 3 1/2" Mark D
 from feet fabric cut: two 1" x 1 1/2" Mark E
 from ear fabric cut: cut one 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" Mark EAR



from background cut: one 1" x 1" Mark F
 one 1" x 1" Mark G
 one 3 1/2" x 4" Mark H
 one 1" x 2 1/2" Mark J.
 one 4 1/2" x 6" mark K
 one 2" x 2" Mark L
 one 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Mark M
 one 2 1/4" x 2 1/2" Mark N
 one 2 1/2" x 3 1/4" Mark O
 one 2 1/2" x 8" Mark P
 one 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" Mark Q
 one 2 1/2" x 4" Mark R
 one 2 1/2" x 8 1/4" Mark S

Make the body: Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on background F. Place on top right of body A. Sew on the line. Trim seam to 1/4". Open out and press.

Sew feet E to legs C. Sew one leg to each side of background H. Press. Sew leg unit to lower edge of horse body.

Tail unit: Sew background G to one end of tail D and J to other end. Press.

Sew tail unit to right side of horse body. Sew background K to left side of horse body.

To make the head: Draw a diagonal line of background L. Place on top left of head B. Sew on line. Trim seam to 1/4". Open out and press.

Draw a diagonal line on background M. Place on right side of head C. Sew on line. Trim seam to 1/4". Open out and press.

Sew background N to left side of head unit. Sew background O to right side of head unit. Sew head unit to top edge of horse body unit.

Sew background P to right side of horse block.

To make ears: Draw a diagonal line on EAR square. Place on lower edge of background Q paying attention to orientation. Sew on line. Trim seam to 1/4". Open out and press. Sew background R to left side of ear. Sew background S to right side of ear unit. Sew ear unit to top edge of horse block.

Square horse block to 9 1/2" x 12 1/2".

You will need three horse blocks and one flower block for this row.
