

Make top and bottom borders:

From strip sets cut six 10 1/2" segments.

Sew three segments together with a 1 1/2" fence post between each one and one to each end of fence border.

Cut two backgrounds each 6" x 6 1/2" and sew one to each end of fence border trimming ends to fit if necessary.

Sew a 2 1/2" background strip to top of fence border. Press.

Use remaining three 10 1/2" segments to make another border this way. Sew one flower block cornerstone to each end of the top border and one to each end of the bottom border.

Sew borders to top and bottom edges of quilt.

Layer backing, batting and quilt top and quilt as desired. Bind edges.

To make flower cornerstones: (make four)

To make one flower cornerstone:

Refer back to the pattern for the **FLOWER BLOCK** and make the flower block following those instructions, but eliminating the stem and leaves section. Your flower block should square to 5 1/2" x 5 1/2".

From background fabric cut two rectangles each 2" x 5 1/2". Sew one to top and one to bottom of flower block

From background fabric cut two rectangles each 2" x 8 1/4" and sew to sides of block.
Square to 8 1/4" x 8 1/4"
